Katha Pollitt writes the "Subject to Debate" column in *The Nation* and is the author of three collections of columns and essays, *Reasonable Creatures*, *Subject to Debate*, and *Virginity or Death!: And Other Social and Political Issues of Our Time*. She has won many prizes and awards for her writing, including two National Magazine Awards, a National Book Critics Circle Award, and fellowships from the Guggenheim Foundation, the National Endowment for the Arts, and the Whiting Foundation. Pollitt is also a poet, with one book, *Antarctic Traveller*, and many poems in *The New Yorker* and other magazines. She has taught at Princeton, Barnard, and the Graduate faculty of the New School, and spoken at dozens of colleges and universities, from the University of Pennsylvania and Yale to St. Benedict's College in Minnesota
