## **PROGRAM PROPOSALS AND COMPETITIVE PAPERS**

**Program proposals** focusing on a unifying theme relevant to interpersonal communication theory, research, or instruction are encouraged. Programs may consist of a chair, presenters, and a respondent, however, roundtable discussions and other unique formats which encourage engaged interaction among panelists and audience members are also invited. Proposals should include: (a) thematic title of the program, (b) name, address, phone/email, and affiliation of each participant; and (c) a title and brief description of each presentation.

**Competitive papers** demonstrating your best theoretical or empirical work are solicited. Student-authored papers are especially encouraged.

### **Electronic Submission:**

All papers and proposals should be submitted by e-mail attachment. Use Microsoft Word or RTF format for all documents. Your electronic submission should include **two separate** attachments:

(1) a cover page including the title of the paper; name, address, phone, email address, and affiliation of each author; please indicate in the upper right hand corner of the cover page if the paper is a **Student** or **Debut** paper.

(2) the paper, including title, a 250-500 word abstract, and no more than 25 pages of text (excluding references and tables). **Remove author names from the paper.**

Electronic submissions must be **received no later than September 1, 2006. Receipt will be confirmed within 48 hours of the submission deadline.**
