- *Special Note: WSCA program planning uses only one deadline for all papers, programs, and workshops.**

Submitted competitive papers to the Media Studies Interest Group (MSIG must include:

- A detachable title page with title of paper, names of all authors, and their address, phone numbers, email addresses, and affiliations. This page will not be shared with reviewers.
- A 250-500 word abstract of the paper with title appearing on same page as the abstract.
- A maximum of 25 pages of text.
- No identifications of the author(s) should appear in the paper beyond the title page.
- Papers submitted by first-time authors must be marked with “DEBUT” in the top of right-hand corner of the title page.

Paper submission guidelines

Program proposal guidelines

Program proposals should be thematically unified. The Media Studies Interest Group (MSIG) encourages a range of program formats, including chair and individual presenters, round-tables, off-site venues, and other formats. The MSIG also encourages co-sponsorship with other interest groups.

Program proposals must include:

- Thematic title for the program
- Names, address, phone numbers, email addresses, and affiliations of *all* participants
- Title and abstract for each individual presentation
- Equipment needed for the program. Please note: Equipment availability is extremely limited.
